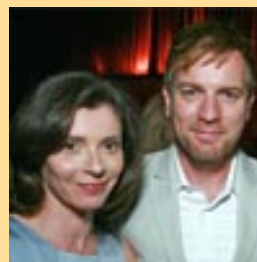

GO staff member Sharon Feder shares with us her recent volunteer visit to Humura House in Kigali, Rwanda.



The children were already playing at the makeshift soccer field as Gilbert, [Humura's](#) Project Coordinator, and I wound our way down the bumpy dirt roads on the outskirts of Kigali.

The roads were lined with simple cement & tin houses closely knit together - no backyards, no grass, and in most cases with front doors made from hanging bed sheets rather than a physical door. The neighborhood was very clean, and people smiled & waved to us as we drove by.

Arriving at the scrimmage field, we were greeted by 14 year old Grace and a few of her classmates. Within minutes of joining the game, it was easy to see how Grace, playing barefoot, dominated the game. Her power on the field matched [\(keep reading>>\)](#)
