Thanks to funds raised at our GO GO Gala, over 100 students at **Comunidad Campesina de Huama in Peru** are better equipped to do well in school because they now have chairs and desks. NextAid's joint project with the [Kawangware Street Children and Youth Project](#) (KSCYP) that helps children and single mothers in the slums of Kenya while helping them build better working conditions. The two-day event started with "World Entrepreneurship Day" educating students about KSCYP's eco-friendly paper-bag micro-business and culminated with an "International Fair." The event was attended by 1,500 students and raised \$400 for this life-saving project in the Kenya slum of Kawangware.



And across the Pacific, **Ka'elepulu Elementary School** in Kailua, Hawaii organized a fundraiser for GO called "[Coins for Kenya](#)". In just three weeks students raised \$665 by collecting only change, proving that every coin counts. Mahalo!
